#### **AGRODEP Web Portal Survey Results**

AGRODEP recently conducted its first annual user survey for agrodep.org. The survey was open to AGRODEP members and was designed to give the AGRODEP team a better understanding of what users need and want from the portal. Out of AGRODEP's 118 members, 33 participated in the survey. Overall satisfaction with the site was high, at 85%. Users were also asked to rate the overall look of the site, usefulness of search results, load speed, and overall ease of navigation; all of
