AGRODEP conducts a number of ongoing activities throughout the year for its members. AGRODEP's training courses take place throughout the year and are open to all AGRODEP members. Each course is designed to present participants with hands-on instruction in the latest modeling and analysis techniques and theories. Each year's training course series is based on members' feedback to ensure that courses cover relevant, timely topics.

AGRODEP members can apply for <u>Research Valorization grants</u> at any point during the year. These grants are open only to AGRODEP members and provide financial assistance for members to present research at international conferences, as well as to pay publication submission fees. AGRODEP also offers a special annual award for excellence in publication.
