AGRODEP Members' Workshop

AGRODEP held its annual Members' Workshop on November 19-20 in Dakar, Senegal. Twenty-one AGRODEP members were invited to attend this year's workshop to present work for which they have received AGRODEP grants; twenty members attended the event. The presentations covered a wide range of research topics, from potential climate change impacts and the natural resource curse to price volatility and women's education. Presenters have received Research Valorization grants and Seed Fund grants, and have submitted proposals for the 2013 AGRODEP Innovative Research grants.

Meetings of the Scientific Advisory Board (SAB), Network Advisory Committee (NAC), and Steering Committee (SC) were held prior to the workshop. Members of these governance committees, as well as members of AGRODEP management, discussed AGRODEP's 2013 activities and progress, as well as work plans for the coming year.
