AGRODEP AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN PUBLICATION

On November 23, 2011, the AGRODEP Consortium launched the AGRODEP Award for Excellence in Publication. The objective of this initiative is to provide an incentive for, and to reward excellent publications by AGRODEP members in top ranking academic journals.

The initiative will help increase member's visibility both within and outside of Africa and contribute to AGRODEP's overall policy impact.

AGRODEP members can apply for this award upon publishing in a top ranking academic journal. To apply, members must submit their publication to the AGRODEP management team along with an explanation on how the publication has benefited from the AGRODEP initiative. The AGRODEP management team will make the decision in consultation with the Co-Chairs of the AGRODEP Scientific Advisory Board (SAB).

The award differs based on the ranking of the academic journal where the publication appears and is given per publication rather than per author.

AGRODEP Grants Program

As part of its Grants Program, AGRODEP offers a Research Valorization Grant which allows members to apply for financial support from the Consortium in order to present the outcome of their research at international conferences.

The first conference grant was awarded to Francis Mwaura, an AGRODEP member since April 2011. The grant enabled Francis to present his research on the valuation of protected areas in Uganda at the 25th International Congress for Conservation Biology (ICCB) held in Auckland, New Zealand on December 5-9, 2011.
