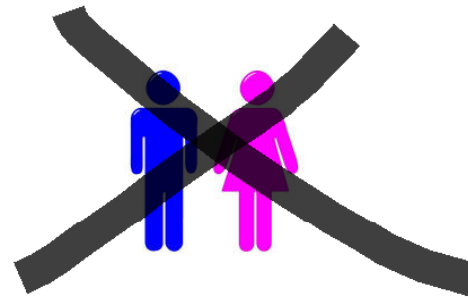

2010: First Round of AGRODEP Membership

○ Dissemination

- African researchers from GTAP and PEP research networks

○ Selection process

- Location criteria
- Education and professional experience criteria
- Research experience criteria
- Diversity criteria

○ Results: 29 members

- Gender: 19 men and 10 women
- Geographic representation: 9 West Africa, 8 East Africa, 6 North Africa, 4 Southern Africa, and 2 Central Africa
- Country representation: 16/53 African countries
- Institutional representation: 10 national research institutions, 10 universities, 7 Africa-based international institutions, 2 government institutions

2011: Second Round of AGRODEP Membership

○ Objectives

- Reach a critical mass of economic modeling experts in three phases of the membership extension: 2011 (50-75 members); 2012 (75-100 members); 2013 (100-150 members).
- Allow for greater diversity in its membership profile and improved geographical distribution within Africa.

○ Extension Agenda

- **Dissemination and acceptance of applications (March-April)**
 - Outreach list of 50 African research centers and universities + members, SAB, SC, NAC, Partners, Friends = 150 individuals and institutions;

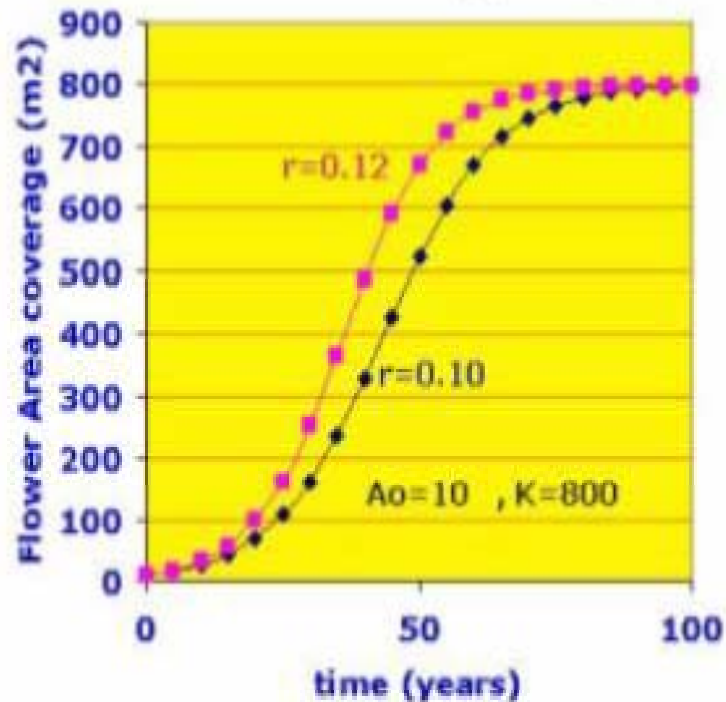
GRANTS PROGRAM

Logistic growth

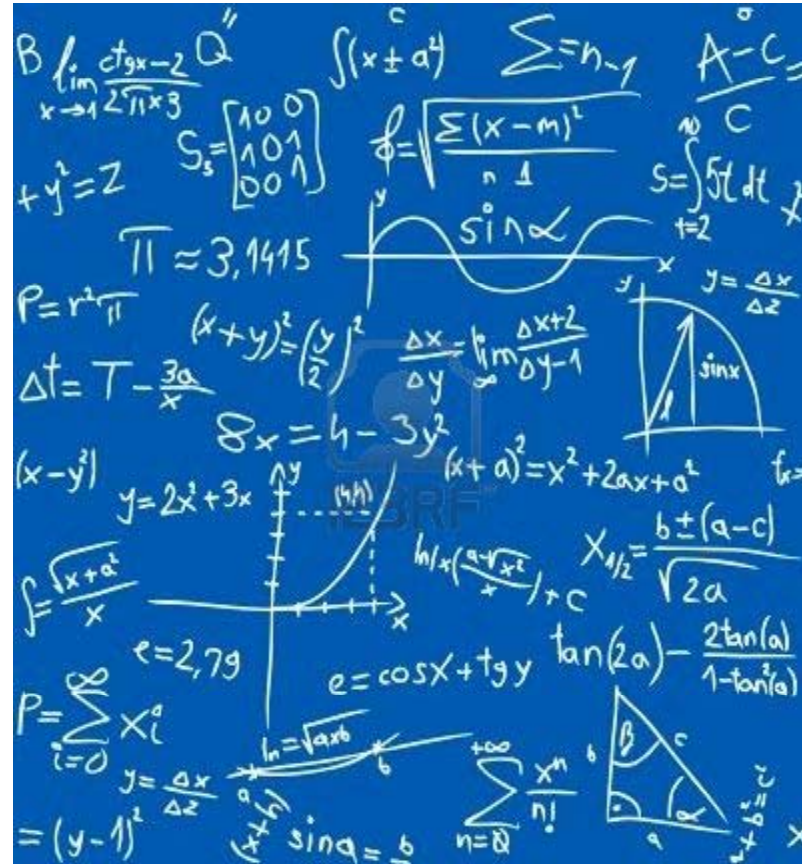
$$A(t) = \frac{A_0 e^{rt}}{1 + A_0(e^{rt} - 1)/K}$$

MODEL COMPONENT ACTIVITIES (2010-2011)

- Six categories of model by September 2011
 - Multi country, Multi sector general equilibrium model.
 - Single country, general equilibrium models.
 - Multi markets partial equilibrium models.
 - Partial equilibrium trade models.
 - Econometrics models of trade.
 - Supply and Demand estimation models.



DATA COMPONENT

A Common Database Platform

AGRODEP will bring together various types of data in a central clearinghouse with a Web data portal

Main Goals:

- To bring together dispersed and disparate statistical, economic, and geospatial data in Africa;
- To provide links to existing key data sources;
- To develop shared standards, formats, and exchange protocols;



DATA COMPONENT

○ **Set-up Activities**

- Data Stocktaking – sources and types of data
- Identification of data experts
- Data portal development
- Development of standards and protocols
- Posting of available data
- Priority setting

○ **Data Warehousing**

- data focus for each half-year period
- acquisition, catalogue\metadata, quality checking, data expert consultations, dissemination and maintenance

○ **Special Data Projects**

- to address data gaps and support models

○ Broad Data Categories

- *based on priority setting*
- national agricultural and economic statistics
- international data sets (trade, tariffs)
- household survey data
- social accounting matrices
- socio-economic development indicators

○ Data Projects

- *handled through grants or collaborative agreements*
- data templates for specific models (e.g. gravity models, multi-market models)
- development of data methodology (e.g. harmonization of agric surveys & SAMs)
- building new or updated SAMs and inclusion in a global database (e.g. GTAP)
