

Results of 2012 Member Satisfaction Survey of AGRODEP Web Portal

Executive Summary

Background

2012 marks the first year the AGRODEP Web Team is conducting a member satisfaction survey for the AGRODEP Web Portal. The survey was administered from December 16, 2012 to January 15, 2013 and was designed to gain a better understanding of what AGRODEP members need from the web. The results of the survey will be used for quality control purposes and to help identify areas of potential improvement.

Target audience

AGRODEP members including 2010 members, 2011 members, 2012 members, and 2012 special call members

Methodology

Sample Size: 33 members participated, out of 118 members (participation rate: 28 %)

Summary of the survey

- Low response rate: Even though the average internal online survey response rate¹ is 30-40%, our response rate (28%) is still low. It would be good to offer small incentives² for the survey next year to encourage member participation.
- Respondents rated their satisfaction with the AGRODEP Web Portal:
 - Overall satisfaction: 86%
 - Overall look: 90%
 - Overall load speed: 84%
 - Overall search: 84%
 - Overall navigation: 88%

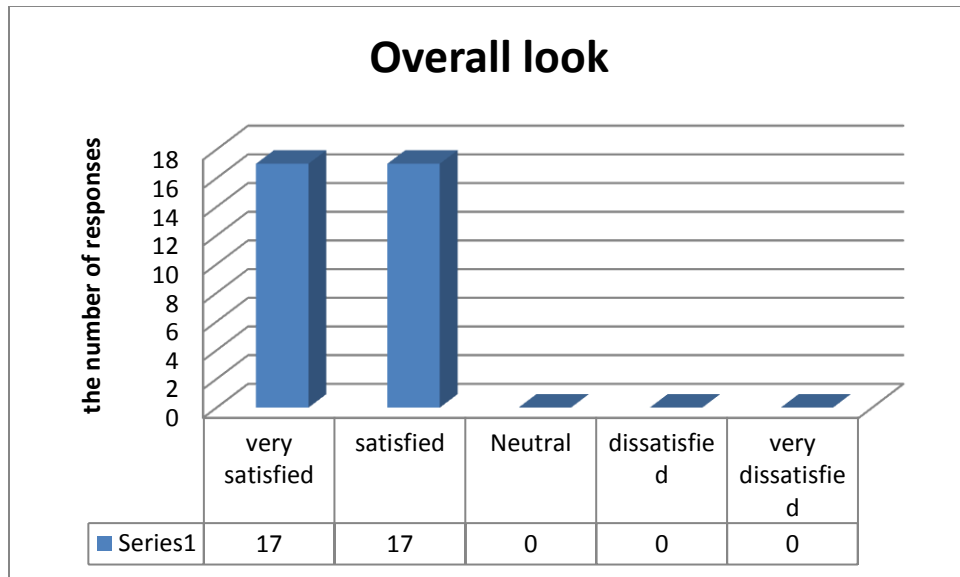

- South Africa, Nigeria, Nigeria, and Malawi are the countries which we need to watch in terms of the load speed based on analysis combining the survey and actual loading time.
- Respondents reported that AGRODEP training information, new members, working papers, and technical notes are not easy to find out in the AGRODEP Web Portal.
- Based on the survey, we might consider updating our navigation to data, resources, and model libraries.
- Respondents would like to find more information on:
 - research papers, including working papers
 - tariff and household data
 - AGRODEP training materials
 - External events and opportunities, including conferences, grants, and fellowships
- Respondents would like to see more conversations regarding research interest areas on the AGRODEP blog.
- 41% of respondents did not know that AGRODEP has social media channels; 20 respondents have a Facebook account.

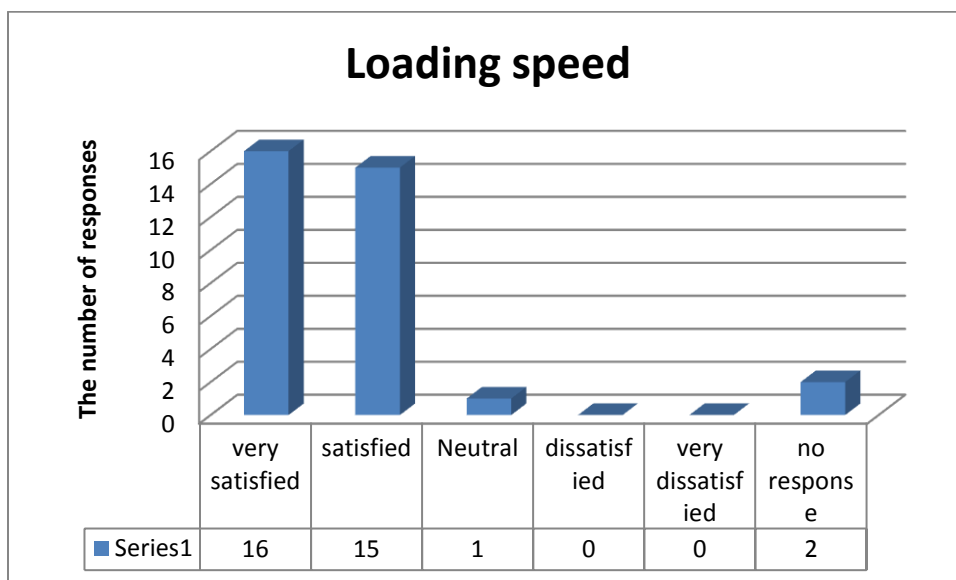
1. Overall Satisfaction

1.2 Load Time

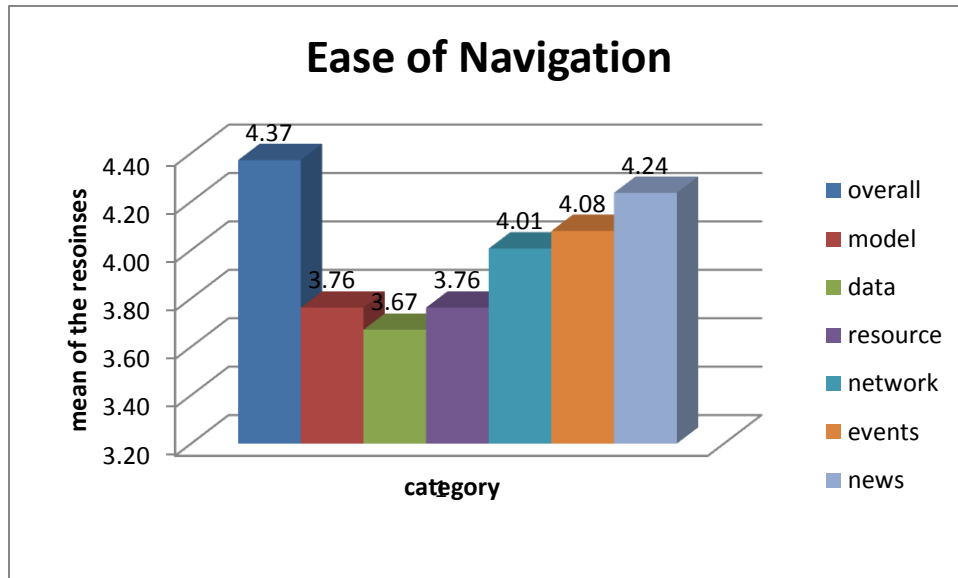

I will blog when I have more sufficient time

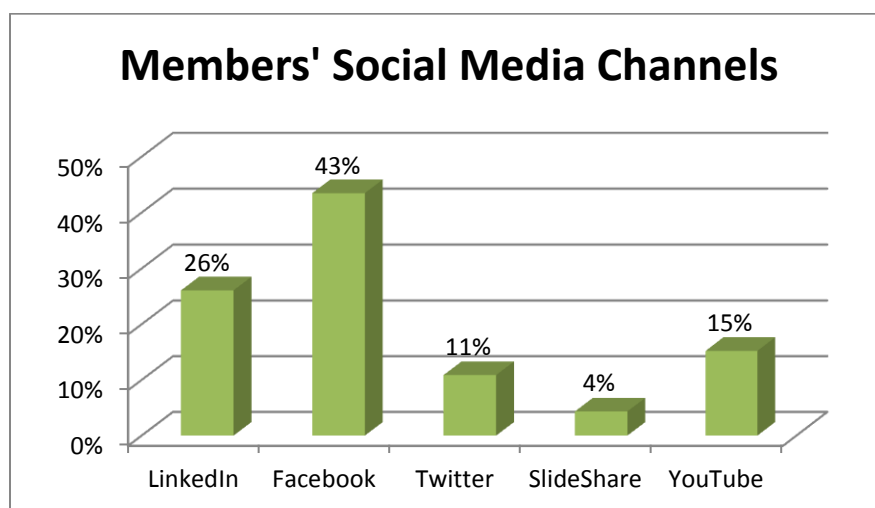
I think I need some time to devote to this outside my tight schedule.
