Seed-fund grants

<u>When</u>: Available following an AGRODEP training course

<u>Award</u>: US \$5000

<u>Eligibility</u>: AGRODEP Members who attended the training course

Procedure:

- Call for proposal, a week following the end of the training course
- Proposals submitted online over two weeks after the opening of the call
- Selection made two weeks after the submission deadline

<u>Guidelines</u>

- Link to the methodology/tools taught in the course
- 4 pages long (recommendation)
- Include the key elements of standard research proposals (Introduction, Literature review, Methodology & Data, Project Timetable Authorship, Funding requirement any additional sources of funding, and References)


